

VISIT OF PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ZAMBIA TO INDIA (AUGUST 20-22, 2019)

President of the Republic of Zambia, Mr. Edgar Chagwa Lungu paid a State Visit to during August 20-22, 2019. President Lungu was accompanied by a high-level delegation including Ministers of Foreign Affairs, Commerce, Trade and Industry, Mines and Mineral, Presidential Affairs and senior Government officials.



The official programme of President Lungu included a ceremonial reception, meeting with President of India, Mr. Ram Nath Kovind and delegation level talks with Prime Minister of India, Mr. Narendra Modi.

President Lungu also participated in India- Zambia Business Forum held in New Delhi.



Seven (7) MoU / Agreements were exchanged during the visit of President of the Republic of Zambia to India. These included; (1) MoU on Cooperation in the field of Geology and Mineral Resources, (2) MoU on cooperation in the field of Defence, (3) MoU on cooperation in the field of Health and Medicine. (Exchangedseparately), (4) MoU on cooperation in the fields of Arts and Culture, (5) MoU between Foreign Service Institute of India and Zambia Institute of Diplomacy and International Studies, (6) MoU for participation in the EVBAB Network Project and (7) MoU between Election Commission of India and Electoral Commission of Zambia.

INDIA-GHANA FOREIGN OFFICE CONSULTATIONS

The 1st India-Ghana Foreign Office Consultations was held in New Delhi on August 28, 2019. The Indian delegation was led by Mr. T.S Tirumurti, Secretary (Economic Relations) and the Ghanaian delegation was led by H. E. Mr. Charles Owiredu, Deputy Minister of Foreign Affairs and Regional Integration.



The consultations provided an opportunity to review the entire gamut of bilateral relations and to look at new areas for cooperation. The two sides also exchanged views on regional and multilateral issues.

The two sides agreed to enhance cooperation inter alia, in areas of trade and investment, development partnership, dèfence & security, health & pharmaceutical sector, capacity building & training and people to people contacts.
