High Commissioner Prashant Agrawal unfurled the national flag, following the national anthem. He then read out Hon. President's address to the nation delivered on the eve of Independence day.

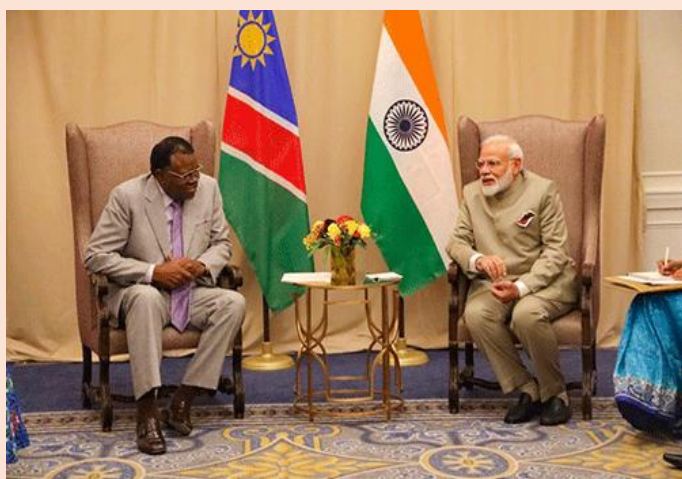

“Namibia and India established diplomatic relations upon Namibia's independence when India opened its High Commission on 21 March 1990,” Geingob said, adding that the diplomatic relations between the two countries culminated in the signing of various memorandums of understanding, aimed at fostering and strengthening the relations between the two countries.

CHEETAH REINTRODUCTION PROJECT

Namibia and India last month signed a deal to export cheetahs to the south Asian country, with the first batch of eight wild cats set to arrive on 15 August 2022 to coincide with India's 75th Independence Day celebrations. Cheetahs, potential candidates for transfer to Kuno NP, MP in due course, undergo thorough 1st health exam by int'l team of experts led by renowned specialist Dr. Laurie Marker. High Commissioner Prashant Agrawal was present.

India has been working to relocate the animals since 2020 when the Supreme Court announced African cheetahs could be introduced in a "carefully chosen location" on an experimental basis. India in the past had Asiatic cheetahs but the species was officially declared extinct within the country by 1952. The deal, signed last month, will see Namibia's cheetahs sent next month to a wildlife sanctuary in the central state of Madhya Pradesh for captive breeding.



BUSINESS-TO-BUSINESS NETWORKING BETWEEN INDIAN AND NAMIBIAN COMPANIES

As part of the ongoing efforts to promote business linkages between Namibian and Indian companies, the High Commission of India in Windhoek, in collaboration with Indo-African Chamber of Commerce and Industry(IACCI) organised a virtual online B2B meetings for Namibian companies with their Indian counterparts over a period of 2 days from 9-10 August 2022.

Over 125 Namibian and 150 Indian companies held over 500 interactions. Companies from both sides took part in one-to-one virtual meetings and discussed tie-ups with potential business partners. Focus sectors included agriculture, mining, construction & infrastructure, textile, solar energy, pharmaceuticals, etc

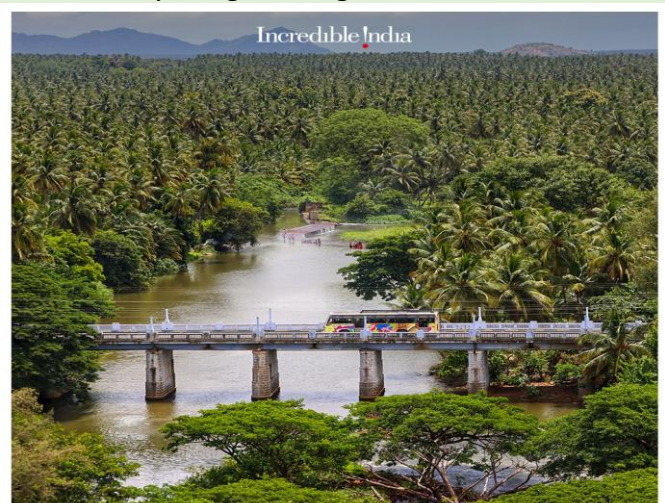
