The scholarships include enrolment and course fees, besides living expenses for the full duration of the course and return economy class airfares to the nearest international airport in India and then train fare to the place of study.

High Commissioner, Mr. Prashant Agrawal greeted the Indian community on the occasion and remembered Guru Nanak Dev ji's life messages and teachings.

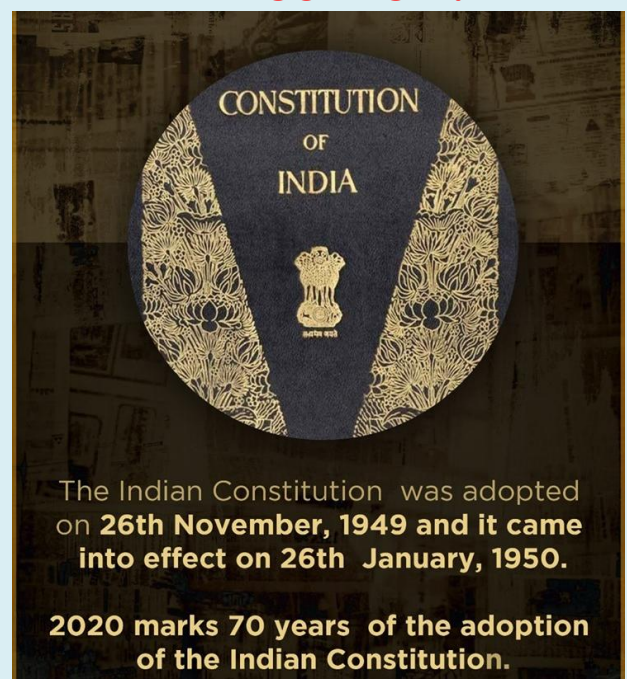


Little girl Nandini recited "Mool Mantra" (Ik Omkar).
