The High Commission of India, Windhoek is organising an exhibition showcasing the rich heritage, diversity and global appeal of **Indian Tea** at **Grove Mall, Windhoek (near Checkers on ground floor)**, from **3 to 9 September 2026**. This is the first Indian tea exhibition to be held in Namibia.

The exhibition will provide visitors an opportunity to discover the fascinating journey of Indian tea—from the tea-growing regions of the country to its place as one of India’s most celebrated agricultural and cultural products. It will highlight the diversity of Indian teas, including the renowned teas from **Assam, Darjeeling and Nilgiri**, as well as India’s long-standing traditions associated with tea cultivation, processing and consumption.

The exhibition will also showcase the historical, cultural and economic significance of tea in India, including the contribution of the Indian tea sector to livelihoods, rural development, trade and exports. Visitors will be introduced to the distinctive characteristics of different Indian teas and the unique geographical regions in which they are cultivated.

The initiative forms part of the High Commission’s efforts to promote greater awareness and appreciation of India’s rich cultural and economic heritage in Namibia and to further strengthen the people-to-people and commercial ties between India and Namibia.

Members of the public, members of the diplomatic corps, the business community, academicians, students and friends of India are warmly invited to visit the exhibition at Grove Mall during the period **3–9 September 2026**.

The High Commission of India looks forward to welcoming visitors and sharing with them the rich story and enduring legacy of **Indian Tea**.
